

You will need:

A plastic storage box (medium to large in size)

Dry grass or straw

Dried leaves and twigs

A carrier bag

- Ask an adult for help with this bit! They need to cut air vents on the two sides of the box and a doorway for the hedgehog to fit through.
- 2. Scatter some of the dried leaves inside the box, then put a nice cosy layer of clean, dried grass or straw on top. Perfect for snuggling down into when the weather gets cold!
- 3. Tuck the box in a quiet and private area of your garden, close to a hedge.
- 4. Ask an adult to help you cut open a carrier bag and place the over the top of the box, then cover it with the remainder of your dried grass, leaves and twigs.
