About Us


Tamar Vets are proud to be an independent, long-standing, 'heart of the community' practice. Richard and Jon are at the helm and are very much into providing a healthy work-life balance for their team, as well as promoting excellent care to our wonderful patient and client base.

Tamar Vets has its main practice in Bude, with 2 branches located in Holsworthy and Hartland.

The practice has recently invested in laparoscopic equipment, electrochemotherapy and a new lab suite. Not only are they investing in equipment, but also in their staff, actively encouraging CPD and certificates.

Tamar is not like other GP practices. We cover our own out-of-hours and 24-hour patient care, meaning we do not refer everything and get to see and nurse a wide range of cases. We also have Vets with specific interests in Cardiology, Orthopaedics, Oncology and Dentistry, aiding with the varied caseload we get to see.

We are an accredited nurse training practice (and once trained, our nurses never seem to want to leave!)



About the role

We are looking for RVNs for full-time and part-time positions. We cover our own OOH and all of the nurses participate in this equally. This means fewer weekends and nights for all! Our current OOH demands are 1 in 8 weekends and 5 weeknights spread over 8 weeks of rota. Alongside the usual salary, a retainer is paid for weeknights and weekends worked, AND as well as that, any work carried out OOH is paid at a special hourly rate.

A full-time position can be flexible, consisting of 34-40 hours per week, split over 4 days, and when it is your turn for a weekend, time is given in lieu during the week to compensate. Saturdays, the practice is open 9-1; the rest of the weekend is on-call. Tamar has provided the nurses with a cosy wooden cabin to stay in whilst covering OOH.

Our nurses are encouraged to work to their full potential, promoting Schedule 3 to be carried out, endorsing a variety of nurse clinics, enhancing our patient care, and whatever your fresh set of eyes sees that we can improve on! So, whether you prefer anaesthesia, surgery, inpatients or nurse clinics, etc., you will be able to grow as a nurse whilst also retaining all nursing skills.



Salary

Up to £33,450 for 40 hours, depending on experience, plus a higher hourly rate for OOH worked hours, 6.5 weeks annual leave, including bank holidays.

Benefits include:- RCVS, VDS fees, company pension scheme, private health insurance, three days CPD per annum fully funded, discounted veterinary fees, career progression opportunities – Certification in areas of interest supported. BVA and SPVS Practice membership.
